Even after he left for England, we kept in touch and I always asked him for his opinion on subjects that might have an impact on our association.

His health had already forced him to give up his role as leader of a French conversation group in Warwick. During our last telephone conversation, he told me how tired he was, but I had no idea that we would never speak again.

Roger was also Chairman of FAFICS for almost 4 years and, there too, left his mark as a brilliant and sociable participant. We attended several FAFICS Board meetings together, where he was able to put his quick wit and interpersonal skills to good use.
