The UNJSPF Certificate of Entitlement (CE) has been dispatched and should be with you shortly.

This year the Certificates for beneficiaries in France, Switzerland and Italy have been sent by pouch to the Geneva UNJSPF Office and are being distributed directly by that Office through the United Nations Office in Geneva (UNOG) mailing facilities. Beneficiaries residing in these countries should expect to receive the Certificate within the next two weeks.

Certificates for those in other countries have been dispatched from the New York Office of the Pension Fund as usual.

Please sign the form as soon as possible as its return guarantees the payment of your pension. ONLY those who are unable to sign the form should affix a thumbprint witnessed by a UN system official, attending physician or local government authority.

We encourage those beneficiaries in Europe to return the Certificate to the UNJSPF Office in Geneva (CCPPNU, c/o Palais des Nations, 1211 Genève 10) who will take responsibility for forwarding it to New York.

You are also encouraged to check - say some three to four weeks after you have sent the Certificate to the Pension Fund - on its progress. This can be done by logging into the Pension Fund website: [www.unjspf.org](http://www.unjspf.org) and clicking on the tab which says "CE Tracking System". This system will enable you to find out if your Certificate of Entitlement has been received by the Fund. To log into the Tracking System you will need to register (if you have not already done so) in order to receive a password. Remember to have your retirement (R/) number at hand when registering on the UNJSPF website.
