



PENSION ADJUSTMENTS - APRIL 2012

The UN Joint Staff Pension Fund has announced the changes to pensions

- or in a number of cases – the “non changes” as of April 2012.

There are no increases for pensioners on the local track in Switzerland, Italy, Norway or Sweden.

Increases are announced for those on the local track in Andorra (4.1%), Australia (3.1%), Austria (3.2%), Belgium (3.5%), Canada (2.3%), Croatia (2.0), Cyprus (5.7%), Denmark (2.5%), Finland (2.9%), France (2.4%), Germany (3.8%), Greece (2.4%), Hungary (4.1%), Ireland (3.8%), Luxembourg (3.2%), Netherlands (4.3%), Portugal (3.6%), Spain (2.4%), Turkey (10.5%) and the UK (4.8%)

Those on the dollar track or in the USA will benefit from an increase of 4.5%.

Please note that these amounts refer to the increase of at least 2% from December to December in the Consumer Price Index (which is composed of several basic products and may drastically differ from your perception of the amount paid when you go shopping).
